Brewer Main Street Study Public Meeting and Comment Period

Bangor, April 28, 2006: The Bangor Area Comprehensive Transportation System (BACTS) will hold a public meeting and solicit comments from the public on the Draft Final Report of the Brewer Main Street Study. This study conducted by Gorrill-Palmer Consulting Engineers, Inc. assessed the current and future transportation needs of the Brewer Main Street corridor from State Street to Wilson Street. This report lays out a plan that will guide short and long-term transportation improvements and strategies along this corridor.

Some of the proposed recommendations include realignment of Betton Street and Parker Street to create a four-leg intersection; relocation of the traffic signal from Center Street to the newly aligned Betton Street/Parker Street intersection; coordination of the traffic signals in favor of northbound traffic; and elimination of on-street parking to provide two southbound travel lanes, and turn lanes where necessary.

The public meeting will be held in Council Chambers at the Brewer City Hall, 80 North Main Street, Brewer at 7:00 pm on May 10, 2006. Comments shall be made in writing and received on or before 4:00 p.m., May 19, 2006. A copy of the report is available on the BACTS website at: <http://www.bactsmmpo.org>.
